

Service Fee Policy for Non Members

The New Zealand Manufacturers and Exporters Association (NZMEA) is supported by the Mancan Foundation and membership fees. Both are registered charities. Our charitable objectives include the support of all manufacturers and exporters in New Zealand and the need to inform the general public and policy makers on things that matter to manufacturers and exporters and the value of tradeable activity to the economy.

- We provide a number of events and services to members at no charge - MEAssist, meetings with policy makers, the Presidents Function, Executive Meetings and the Council and CEO Forum meetings.
- A number of other events are supplied at a cost that covers only the variable cost of the particular event.
- All events and services are supplied at well under market cost to our members.

Our policy in support of non-members is as follows:

General Queries

If the first point of contact in the organisation can answer the question then a verbal answer will be given at no cost. However if the staff member cannot assist, or the answer is required in writing, then we will apply a charge for the use of our support network.

Investment

Use of our investment network or advertising in our member newsletter, by non-members, will attract a charge.

Assistance for Job Seekers

An email will be sent to the Association's network with a brief abstract on the type of work being sought. From responses your CV will then be circulated for interested companies to contact you directly. A charge will apply.
